## Ministry of Education New Delhi, the April, 2022

G.S.R. \_\_\_\_,In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and Govt. of India Gazette notification No. G.S.R 230(E) dated 29.03.2022 and in supersession of the Government Arts and Science Colleges, Chandigarh (Assistant Professor Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2011, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor (Group 'A') in the Government Arts and Science Colleges, Chandigarhnamely:-

- 1. **Short title and commencement.**-(1) These rules may be called the Government Arts and Science Colleges, Chandigarh (Assistant Professor Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2022.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Number of Post, classification and scale of pay.** The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. **Disqualification.** -No person,-
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
  - Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
- 5. **Power to relax.-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.
- 6. **Saving.-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong

	University (Shanghai).
	Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges (as per UGC regulations 2018) shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

	A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the <b>Bachelor's as</b> well as at the Master's levelfor the candidates belonging to:-  (i) Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward  Classes (OBC)/New groups Level / Differently shield ((c))

	Eligibility (A or B): A.

i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.
ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.
Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges /Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:
<ul><li>a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode</li><li>b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;</li></ul>
c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
d) candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal;
e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

	the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affair) of the University concerned.  Note 2: The clearance of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).  OR
